To reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve air quality in our cities, there is a need for a rapid and wide-scale introduction of alternative-fuelled vehicles into publically owned fleets. But how can this be achieved?

The [Clean Fleets Project](#) has been working with public authorities and fleet operators since September 2012 to help implement the [EU Clean Vehicles Directive](#) and encourage procurement of clean and energy efficient vehicles.

Drawing on these experiences, a series of policy recommendations have been drafted to help ensure a supportive policy and legislative framework for future clean vehicle procurement.

In order to ensure these suggestions are pertinent and achievable, EU and national decision-makers are invited to explore the issues raised with the project in a workshop held in Brussels (Belgium).

The morning will include presentations from public procurers and policy experts from [ICLEI Europe](#), the cities of Bremen (Germany), Rotterdam (Netherlands) and Stockholm (Sweden), [Transport for London](#), [TÜV Nord](#), [Polis Network](#) and the European Commission's [Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport](#).

There will also be a chance for open discussion and debate.
