Focus areas and activities:

To frame its work, the Partnership has identified four thematic areas:

- 1. Active modes of transport;
- 2. <u>Innovative solutions and smart mobility;</u>
- 3. Public transport for cities; and
- 4. Governance and planning.

For each of the above-mentioned themes, the Partnership identified bottlenecks and potentials.

Partnership developed the **nine actions which are presented in the Public Feedback and are open to stakeholder feedback**. The actions aim at addressing real needs:

- issues that have real and visible impact
- concern a larger number of Member States and cities;
- actions should be 'innovative' without 'recycling' elements which have already been done or would be done anyway.



Working Group 1 - Active modes and public space (incl. behavioural change)

 - Lead authors: Gdynia
 - Contributors: ECF / Brno / Malmo (tbc)
- 1.3 Urban Vehicle Access Regulations (Knowledge/Regulation)
 - Action underdevelopment
