<p>G. Transfer to Scheemda on a hydrogen bus</p>	<p>Autonomous bus driving in public space</p> <p>Experience the first automated shuttle bus driving on public roads. The shuttle bus covers a 1,5 km distance from the hospital to the nearest bus stop, and caters for patients, visitors and hospital employees.
